The annual conference has been held in various universities across South East Asia (Malaysia, Thailand and Indonesia) over the past nine years.

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Abstract Submission

Researchers who may be interested to submit abstracts should abide by the following guidelines:

- 1) The abstract text should contain no more than 200 words, Arial font size 11, in MS Word format, single-spaced.
- 2) Clearly state the research's title, name of proponent(s), email address(es).
- 3) Indicate the subtheme to which you believe the research (abstract) you submitted could be included.

Submitted abstracts will be evaluated and reviewed. Researchers with accepted abstracts would then be notified and invited to submit full papers for peer review and possible inclusion in the conference proceedings.

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Hotel and Venue

The SEAAIR 2010 conference will be held at the Summit Ridge Hotel & Promenade (<http://www.summitridgehotel.com/>) located at Tagaytay City, overlooking Taal Lake . The mountain top hotel is an hour and a half drive from Ninoy Aquino International Airport in Manila .

Conference participants may avail of the following discounted room rates from the hotel venue during the duration of the conference (October 18 to 21, 2010 only):

Room rates are quoted on a per room per night basis and are inclusive of buffet breakfast.

For participants wishing to arrange for transportation from the airport to the conference venue or to a nearby hotel in the vicinity of Tagaytay City, travel arrangements could be made with the local organizing committee upon registration. A separate fee of \$20 would be charged to each participant wishing to avail of this service; the fee would cover transport from the airport to the hotel and back to the airport. Participants may be asked to ride with other delegates as meet ups and transports would be arranged at a frequency of two hours each."
